Rules and Regulations

Date of Event: August 4th, 2024 at 2 PM General Rules for all classes

- 1. No alcohol allowed in the vehicle. This is strictly enforced by the local police.
- 2. Any driver or pit crew member found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be dealt with by the police. Violators will be disqualified if driver or pit crew members are caught consuming alcohol before the END of the derby or on the fairgrounds.
- 3. ANY DRIVER OR PIT CREW MEMBER THAT THREATENS ANOTHER DRIVER, PIT CREW MEMBER, OR OFFICIAL OR OTHERWISE SHOWING EXTREME POOR SPORTSMANSHIP,

EXCESSIVE DRAMA, ETC. RISKS BEING DISQUALIFIED AND FORFEITING ANY PRIZE MONEY EARNED BY THEM OR THE CAR THAT THEY ARE REPRESENTING.

- Check in time is no later than one hour before the start of the event. PITS OPEN AT 11:00
 A.M. You may pre-register at the fairgrounds during normal business hours if you wish. Entry fees are due before inspection.
- 5. Registration and release forms must be completed prior to inspection. Entry fee for all classes is **\$20.00**
- 6. If ATV/UTV/Dirt Bike fails inspection, you will be allowed to make corrections. If you can't or decline to make corrections, your vehicle will be disqualified.
- 7. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- 8. Contestant numbers are on a first come first served basis. Duplicate numbers will be changed. First car registered keeps the number.
- 9. Drivers must be at least 16 years of age. Photo ID required and notarized parental consent form must be presented if the driver is under 18 years of age. This has to be a legal parent or guardian. All drivers under the age of 18 must have a valid driver's license. Since this is an off road event, drivers 18 years of age and older do not need a driver's license. However, at least a state issued photo ID must be presented. No exceptions.
- 10. No pit crew members under the age of 13. NO EXCEPTIONS! All pit crew members will sign a notarized release form. Pit crew under the age of 18 will also have a notarized release form from a parent or their LEGAL guardian.
- 11. Only the competing vehicle (ATV/UTV/DirtBike) is allowed in the Pit area. Entry fee includes the driver and an additional 1 person pit pass is \$15. Moto Rodeo Pit member limit is 1.
- 12. Drivers meeting is mandatory and will be held 30 minutes before the start of the derby. Drivers are required, and pit crew is encouraged, to attend the drivers meeting. Heats will be drawn at that time, and officials will answer questions that you may have.
- 13. All vehicles must be removed from the fairgrounds the day of the event unless arrangements are made with the event committee or the Big Horn County Fair manager. Vehicles left longer than 24 hours will be hauled off at the owner's expense and possibly forfeited.
- 14. Drivers must wear long pants. Fire suits are recommended.
- 15. Driver must wear an approved crash helmet. Safety goggles are recommended.
- 16. No passengers allowed
- 17. Your vehicle MUST be situated to the starting line approved by the starting line judge.
- 18. Your run will be timed by the starting line judge. ALL TIMES ARE FINAL
- 19. You are allowed to fly flags behind your vehicle but the flags must NOT have any profane or vulgar language. It is a family show, treat it as such.
- 20. Each Rider MUST sign a waiver that includes an emergency contact in case thereof.
- 21. Any rider under the age of 18 will need the signature of a parent or guardian. The parent or Guardian MUST BE PRESENT during the signature. The paperwork can still be turned in early to register & hold your spot.
- 22. Each rider must be equipped with an appropriate helmet while operating their vehicle.
- 23. Any size 4-wheeler is only allowed to run/win/compete in the 4-wheeler class, any size side x side is only allowed to run in the side x side class, and any size dirt bike is only allowed to run in the dirt bike class.
- 24. Patterns for the barrel race will be available below and may be demonstrated prior to the race if needed.
- 25. If a rider breaks the pattern in any way, he/she will be disqualified.
- 26. If a rider knocks over a barrel or pole, he/she will have 5 seconds added per barrel to their time. A rider may touch a pole or barrel to steady it from falling over while remaining on their vehicle. Once the pole/barrel has touched the ground the 5 second will be charged.
- 27. Riders will receive a cash payout at the end of ALL EVENTS. Once the entirety of the event is over, winning riders will meet at the location of the drivers meeting to receive the winnings.

- 28. Entry fees to be paid at time of registration at the check-in table or online with the sign up sheet.
- 29. ALL judges & volunteers are to be treated with respect and courtesy at all times.
- 30. Please listen to the announcer over the loudspeaker for any information. Announcers will refer to drivers as.
 - 1. Current Competing Driver: (ex. John Smith)_____ "UP"
 - 2. Second Competing Driver: (ex. John Smith) "ON DECK"
 - 3. Third Competing Driver: (ex. John Smith)_______"IN THE HOLE"

JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL. Judges will not be subject to verbal or physical abuse by drivers or pit crew.
