BIG HORN COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM
WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND LIABILITY

Liability Statements

1. All participants must comply with the policies and regulations of the Big Horn County Fair. The Big Horn County Fair, its employees, agents, elected and appointed officials will in no case be liable or responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to or with any exhibit. Each participant shall indemnify the Big Horn County Fair, its employees, agents, elected and appointed officials against all legal or other proceedings in regards thereto, as well as damage, injury or loss to any other person or property, caused by the participant, or any other person or property, or any of the animals under the care of him/her, or arising out of, or in any way connected with, such use of any of the animals.

2. I hereby acknowledge that engaging in activities in connection and association with the programs, events and activities of the Big Horn County Fair carries an inherent risk of injury, property damage and financial loss, including, but not limited to, physical, financial risks and risks to property. I also acknowledge and understand the Big Horn County Fair makes no representations, guarantees, assurances or warranties for safety, function or continued participation, in regard to its actions, plans, work, activities, events, equipment or supplies. In full acknowledgment of the inherent risks my voluntary request to participate is hereby consented.

3. I do hereby, for myself, my heirs, personal representatives and assigns release and discharge Big Horn County, the Big Horn County Fair, and/or any of their elected officials, employees, agents, volunteers and their successors and assigns from all actions, causes of action, damages, claims or demands both direct and consequential, for all known or unknown personal injuries, property damage or financial loss resulting from or arising out of, or in connection with, my request to participate in events, activities, programs or other actions in association with or at the direction of the Big Horn County Fair.

4. All participants including but not limited to exhibitors, spectators, vendors, entertainers, superintendents, etc. causing property damage will be responsible to the injured party either by paying for any and all damages directly to the injured party or by paying a subrogation claim made by the injured party's insurance company.

I certify and warrant that I have read and fully understand the foregoing release. Further, I am VOLUNTARILY REQUESTING TO PARTICIPATE AND RELEASING OF LIABILITY freely, voluntarily, and without coercion and in consideration of the opportunity to hold membership with the Big Horn County Fair facilities and other good and valuable consideration. I further certify that I am 18 years of age or older. If I am a minor, my parents or guardian, fully participates in and acknowledges the contents and effects of this waiver and release on my behalf.

Rules and Regulations

Date of Event: August 2nd, 2026 at 2 PM

General Rules for all classes

Tuff Truck competitions require drivers to meet age and safety requirements, vehicles to comply with mechanical and fuel standards, and all participants to follow strict conduct and pit regulations.

Driver Requirements

- Drivers must be at least **16 years old** (some events require 18) and hold a **valid driver's license** Only **one driver per vehicle** is allowed; **no passengers** are permitted
- Drivers must wear **DOT or Snell-approved helmets**, long pants, and long-sleeve shirts, and be secured with **seat belts or racing harnesses**
- Drivers are responsible for the actions of their **crew and family**

Pit and Crew Regulations

- The **pit area is restricted** to those who have signed a waiver and received an official arm band
- Children are **not allowed** in the pit area unless under adult supervision
- Crew members must **avoid alcohol or drugs**; any impairment can result in disqualification.

Vehicle Requirements

- Vehicles can include **trucks, cars, SUVs, minivans, and jeeps**, divided into classes based on **wheelbase**
- Vehicles must be in **good mechanical condition**; unsafe vehicles may be barred from competition
- **Stock frames only**; tube frames are prohibited
- **DOT-approved tires** are required; nitrous oxide, superchargers, turbos, and alcohol fuels are prohibited
- Suspension lift kits are allowed, but **shocks must remain in stock locations**; dual shocks are permitted to reduce breakage
- Engine modifications are limited to **stock or limited performance aftermarket parts**; high-performance racing components are not allowed
- Open or soft-top vehicles must have **roll cages**, and all tailgates and hoods must be secured or modified for safety

Event Conduct

- Competitors must **stop immediately** when a **red flag** is displayed
- Vehicles must **come to a complete stop** after each run and follow official directions
- Drivers must attend a **mandatory driver's meeting** before the event

- Officials have the **final authority** on vehicle eligibility, class placement, and rule interpretation

Safety and Liability

- All participants compete **at their own risk**; compliance with rules does not guarantee safety
 - Fire extinguishers must be **charged, functional, and secured** in the vehicle
 - Helmets, seat belts, and other safety gear are **mandatory** to minimize risk
- These rules are designed to ensure **fair competition, safety, and orderly conduct** during Tuff Truck events, while giving officials discretion to enforce or adjust rules as needed.
