Expectations:

Junior Fair Board goals:

1. To educate youth about local government, how to serve on a board and how to execute change in local communities.
2. To set up scholarship funds for participants.
3. Act as a branch of the Fair Board to help organize and improve the Big Horn County Fair.
4. Allow participants to fill leadership roles and learn about financial decision making.

Time commitments:

1. Ideally: Meetings held once a month, fundraisers held 2x a year and the week of the Big Horn County Fair. The final decision will be up to the Junior Fair Board to set their own time requirements.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Members will abstain from the use of any alcohol, drugs or illegal paraphernalia.
2. The amount of members allowed to serve on the board is not limited. The first board will decide which officers to elect and their specific duties. Members must be between the ages of 14-20 years old.
3. Members must have never been married or pregnant.
4. Members must be legal residents of Big Horn County.
5. Members will be expected to represent JFB in a matter benefitting the Junior Fair Board and must present themselves in official capacities during activities and events.
6. Members will be required to attend the Big Horn County Fair and be required to help out when needed. This may include but is not limited to; handing out ribbons at events, scribing for judges and running ticket booths.
7. Members will be expected to host fundraisers to keep the Junior Fair Board self-sustaining. Trips, scholarships and outfits will come out of the Junior Fair Board's own account.
8. The specific outlines of the board will be decided upon its formation, where the board will write and adhere to its own bylaws and meeting requirements.
